

Practical information LET Workshop

Weather:

The temperature in the Bay Area will likely get down to about 5 deg Centigrade at night, and up to about 15 deg Centigrade during the day. The winter is California's rainy season (in fact, it is raining right now as I type this), so bring appropriate clothing and an umbrella.

Food:

The Stanford Guest House serves continental breakfast every day. The Linear Cafe at SLAC serves breakfast and lunch during the work week. Their menu is at:

For dinner, or for alternate lunch options, there are 3 major business districts which can quickly be reached by car from SLAC.
