# Minutes of WP-meeting 403

#### **Attendance:**

#### **General News:**

Shinya reported that a new professor Ritsuya Hosokawa started in Iwate at the beginning of October. He will mostly work on DUNE, but also on generic TPC and LCTPC topics.

Paul mentioned, that there will be an FCC-France meeting soon in Strasbourg. No-one attended the ECFA, EW and Higgs meeting in Paestum. It seems there were new studies presented, where the backgrounds were estimated. They are quite significant and are not irrelevant as previously assumed.

Huirong reminded that the CEPC-WS will take place next week in Nanjing, Maxim will present the highlights of EAJADE workshop on Sustainability in Future Accelerators and Jochen will give a presentation on GridPix results. Huirong also mentioned the conference on High Energy Physics will again take place in Hong Kong in January 2024. It will include a two-weeks mini-workshops and one week of conference. Maxim reported from the DRD1 collaboration formation process. The proposal was commented on by the DRDC and suggestions for changes have been made. The proposal has to be resubmitted by end of October and then the actual review process will start. On December 4<sup>th</sup> the DRDC will take the final decision on the approval and then the MoU will be released soon afterwards. The signing process will take several months, but RD51 will continue until everything is settled.
