General News:

Paul said there was a technical conveners' meeting, the ILD-CM in January was discussed.

Ron pointed out that at the newslines of the linearcollider.org, there was on November 8th, 2023 the following news: from *Tokyo Web*

(On August 8, it was learned that China is aiming to start construction of a giant circular accelerator with a circumference of 100 km (CEPC) in 2027 to explore the mysteries of the birth of the universe. It is believed that China aims to take the lead in particle physics, competing with Europe's new FCC and the International Linear Collider (ILC) project, which has the Kitakami Mountains in Iwate and Miyagi prefectures as a candidate site.)
