● ITN proposal summary (draft of internal document to IDT-EB)

Each group in WG2 gave a detailed explanation of the WPP to the contact person appointed by the lab.

Based on this, each group **steering members evaluated the responses** (sent by the contact person) in terms of

1. Is the proposal **appropriate for the ITN**?
2. Is there any **overlap** in the proposals among the labs?
3. Is it something that could be handled by a **U.S. lab**, even though the U.S. has not yet progressed in discussions on ITNs after P5?
4. Are there any elements **missing** from the ITN proposal?

The IDT-EB should make a comprehensive judgment based on this whether it is **appropriate as the ITN** and the **potential for the U.S. to contribute in the future**.

Then, we would like the EB **to contact the responsible person** of each laboratory to determine whether or not to implement it as the ITN.

As for the word file, it will be a document for consideration by IDT-EB.

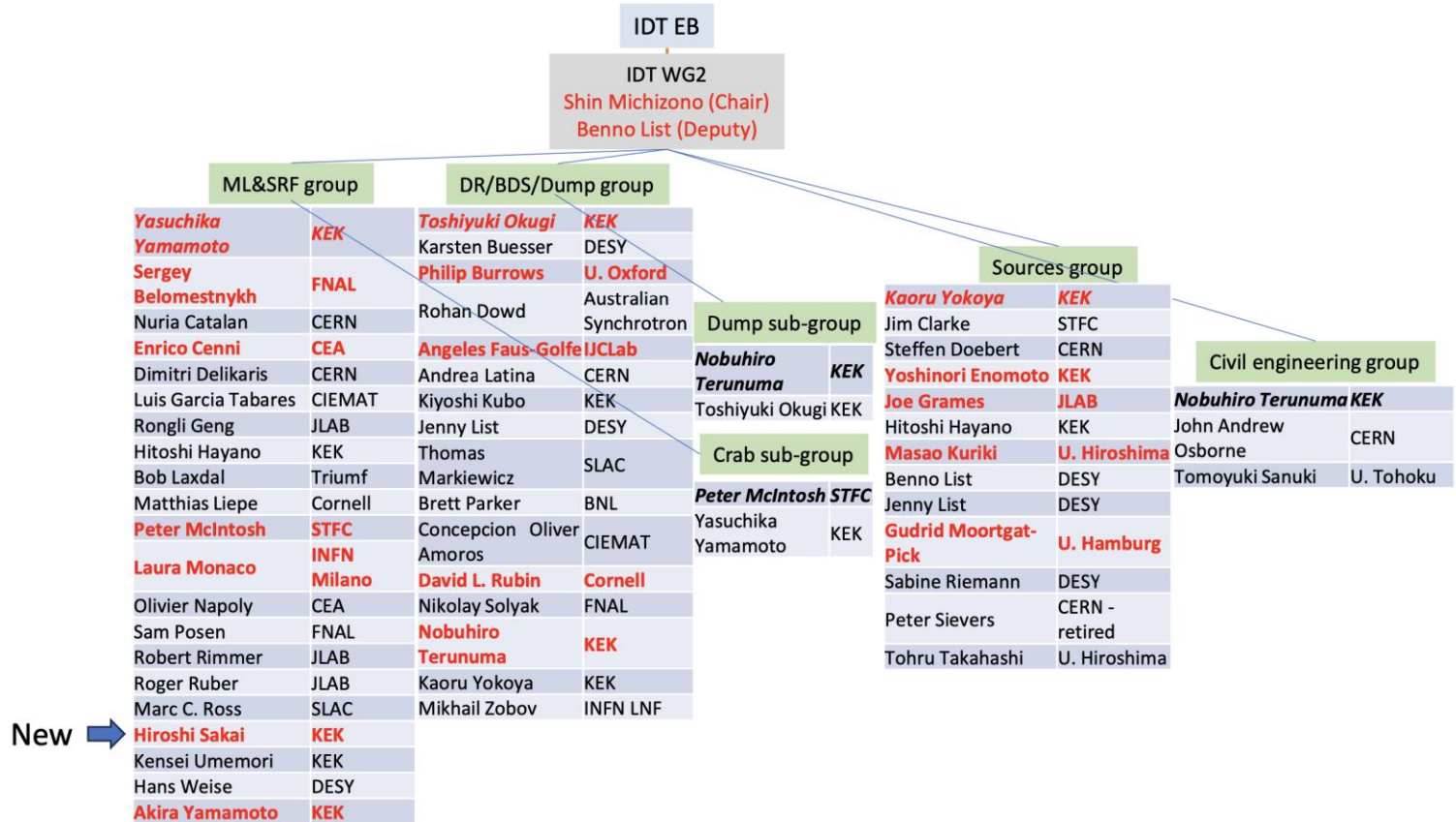
