

Minutes of WP-meeting 457

Attendance:

General News:

There will be a DRD1 meeting on gaseous detectors at the FCCee. Jochen will present LCTPC and the pixelTPC. Also, Huirong will give a talk on the CEPC developments. The meeting will take place on June 16th and it will be fully online. Unfortunately, there will be a heavy flavor FCCee WS in parallel, but the communities should be quite different.

There is also an FCCee WS in Helsinki (<https://indico.cern.ch/event/1552126/>). Several people were asked to present something, but no-one could attend.

Maxim explained that CERN is updating the next five-years mid-term plan (MTP). The new CERN management initiated restructuring the FCCee project, which is now better integrated within the CERN department structure. In 2028 CERN will reach a go/no-go decision about the FCCee. In case of a positive decision the FCCee will be continued, in case of a negative outcome, other options like advanced LEP3, intermediate energy LC or a muon collider will be considered. During the next few years, no technical studies will be performed for alternative options, mostly sort of "paper studies" (e.g. a cost model with uncertainties and associated risk analysis) are possible with a funding between 5 and 10 MCHF per year.

LCWS will take place at KEK from November 9th to November 13th.

A new ILD spokesperson was elected. Mary-Cruz Fouz will be the successor of Ties. We should get into contact with her and maybe invite her to a WPmtg and the next CM. The official hand over will take place in the September ILD meeting. Ties will still be around, but will not have any official position anymore.

We should get involved more in the FCCee detector concept meetings and should try to follow them. Ties gave a presentation on ILD on May 4th during the last meeting.

News from the groups:

Paul and Serguey are going to Japan around the 12.5. They will meet Daniel and Shinya and join them at the Japanese Particle Physics Workshop at Hamamatsu on the 14th and 15th. Afterwards Paul and Serguey will go to Tsukuba and stay until the 28th.
