RDR

- "Suggest to the RDR groups that they document the detailed work for the RDR as 'ILC reports', which can then in principle be referenced in the RDR document itself." (Nick)
- ILCDoc can provide:
 - collection "Report"
 - numbering scheme ILC-REPORT-2007-nnn
 - requesting the record name and later submit the file(s)
 - access restriction: INTERNAL (?)



- Test on migrating few "Public" documents to ILCDoc
 - Metadata successfully extracted+transferred+converted+uploaded
 - Files uploaded
- Directory structure with many levels and access restrictions
 - Can this structure be mapped into our cat tree ?
 - 755 "public" documents, but most of them are stored in users personal directories
 - Many folders have restricted content
- Need to have/know:
 - Lest of files and/or directories that need to be saved
 - Documents that can be INTERNAL or need to be PRIVATE
 - if private... who should be granted access to them
