EUROTeV Scientific Report



- Purpose

- compile in one document the findings of EUROTeV

- in a scientific language

- with a broader view

- use and condense the individual reports and extract the overall/concluding message

- in particular make reference to the reports that constitute deliverables

- and in an attractive form

- Process

- profit from the usual end-of-the-year reporting

- and from Final Report



Scientific Report \Leftrightarrow Annual Report

- Annual Report
 - mixes scientific language with resources (FTE) and organisational issues
 - contains management sections etc.
 - refers to 2008 only
- Scientific Report
 - will be a scientific document

Authors



- Report should contain a list of all researchers who at one time contributed to EUROTeV including institute affiliation
- The document will be edited by
 - P Burrows, E Elsen, D Schulte and N Walker
 - with input compiled by the work package coordinators
 - who receive contributions from the task managers
 - and the individual authors of reports

Format



- LaTeX
 - references
 - figures
 - layout
- Input sources can still be Word files

Timelines



- EUROTeV Deliverables first
Typically that is a EUROTeV report
- Preparation of the Annual Report
 - usual procedure
 - deadline before Christmas
- Scientific Report
 - in parallel
- The input to the Final Report
