ILD website

- current ILD website
 - <http://www.ilcild.org/>
 - the current maintainer (D. Karlen) has taken over other responsibilities and is unable to contribute to further maintenance activities
- new website
 - inherits data from the current website
 - (temporary) location: <http://www-ild.kek.jp/>
 - web site maintained by me
(A. Miyamoto responsible for the server)

infrastructure

- The server:
 - dual Pentium III @ 800 MHz
 - 756 MB RAM
 - sits in the KEK-DMZ network
 - latency to other networks:
 - --- www.desy.de ping statistics ---
10 packets transmitted, 0 received, 100% packet loss, time 8999ms
 - --- polype.in2p3.fr ping statistics ---
10 packets transmitted, 10 received, 0% packet loss, time 9004ms
rtt min/avg/max/mdev = 297.831/298.541/298.988/0.827 ms
 - --- www1.slac.stanford.edu ping statistics ---
10 packets transmitted, 10 received, 0% packet loss, time 9004ms
rtt min/avg/max/mdev = 117.224/117.827/118.504/0.627 ms
- The software:
 - Scientific Linux 5.4
 - Plone ver. 3
 - Apache web server (for port forwarding)

ILD documents in Plone

- the data from the old website was over 2 GB (!)
 - 750 MB even after dropping the version changes
 - something to think about for DBD documenting strategies...
 - Plone back-up is done by copying one big file

changes made to the new website

- cleaned up the documents folders
- introduction material added to the front page
- working group documents
- “workbook” for ILD software started
 - analysis walkthrough
 - target newcomers to the group
 - help needed in writing the Mokka section

user registration

- creating an account with the web site allows you to create and edit pages.
 - create an account by filling out the online forms. Then wait until the confirmation email is sent (typically <24 hours).
 - the time delay exists because it takes that long for the spam filter (me) to process the request
 - example spam:
 - You are receiving this mail because heatherf.minor@gmail.com is requesting an account on www.ilcild.org.
