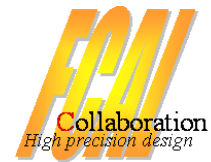


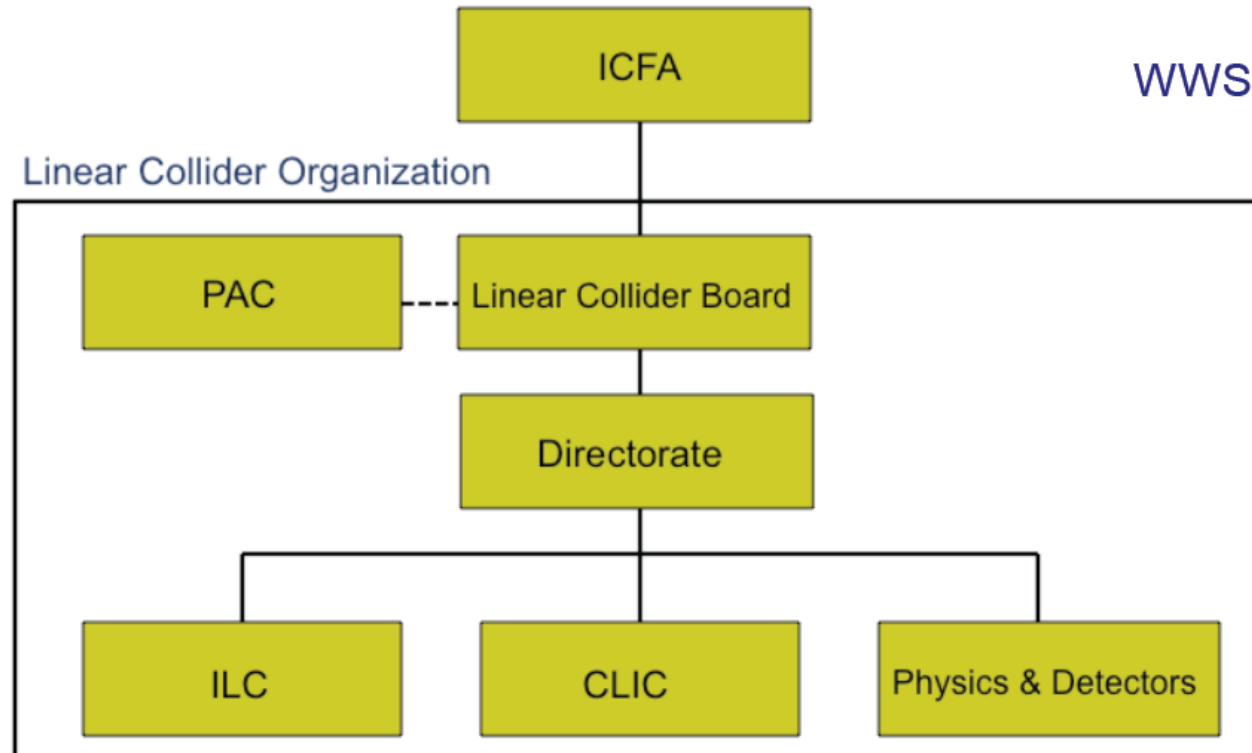

- ILD after 2012

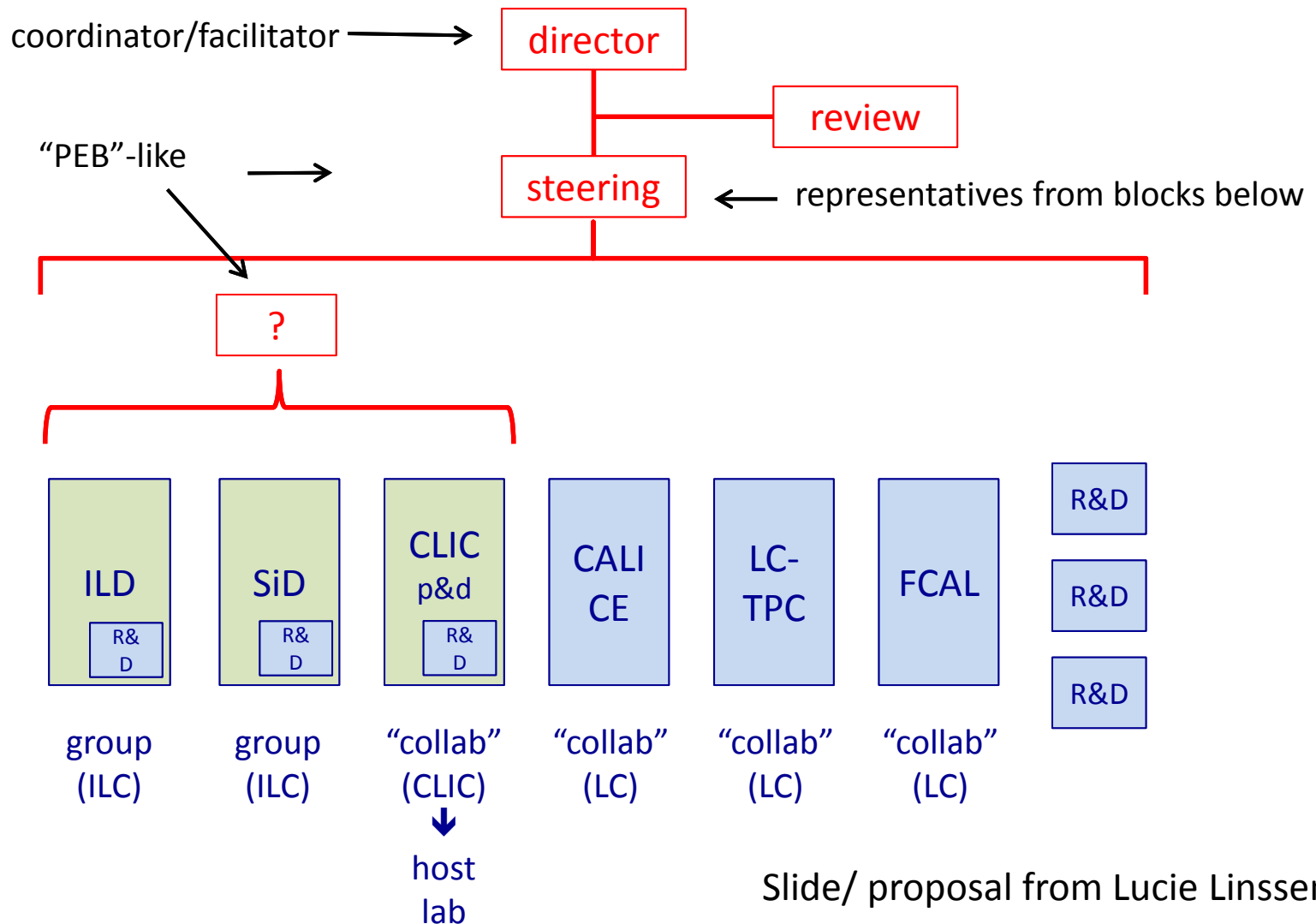


ILCSC Proposal

What should be our next goal?

- Depends on the overall situation
- Depends on our wishes and on funding possibilities

Some questions we might ask

- How important is the role of the concept groups?
- What are our relations to the R&D groups?
- What is our relation to the CLIC effort

ILD after 2012

Obvious things which we need to do

- Fundamental: does it make sense to make another fundamental optimization?
- Less fundamental: we have seen that there are many open questions no show stoppers, but many detailed problems
 - LHCAL
 - Make a more coherent overall integration and optimization
- Lots of engineering (but probably only want to do this seriously once we move close to the real axis?)
- Physics studies: define the LC physics in view of the LHC results

R&D will and need to continue!
