## 1) Report from the Spokesperson

In his report on recent FCAL activities A. LEVY initiated discussion of FCAL Working Groups (WG) proposing <u>Hardware WG to be put in place in addition to the existing Clustering WG</u>. M. IDZIK agreed to convene the Hardware WG. TB results should be handled by this group. There was discussion if a third one, the Physics WG is needed as proposed by (I. BOZOVIC JELISAVCIC). It has been agreed to monitor the progress with the two WG for the time being.

## 2) Report from the Publication and Speakers Committee

There was a brief discussion with the Chair of the Publication and Speakers Committee (K. ELSENER) about the author list for the FCAL contribution to the ICHEP14 proceedings. <u>This</u> brought to the conclusion that MoCs have to be put in place, together with the publication policy. A. LEVY committed himself to prepare the document to be distributed to the FCAL IB for discussion until the end of the year.

## 3) Possible addition of the Kiev group to the FCAL collaboration

A. LEVY also reported on interest of the group from the University of Kiev (Ukraine) to join the FCAL with the possible contribution on LHCAL. After discussion, it was agreed that they should be asked by the FCAL IB Chair for the letter of interest after which the FCAL IB will decide of inviting them to the next FCAL WS.

#### 4) The next FCAL WS in 2015

K. ELSENER proposed, and it get subsequently confirmed, that <u>the 26th FCAL WS will take place</u> <u>at CERN, 23-24 March 2015</u>.
