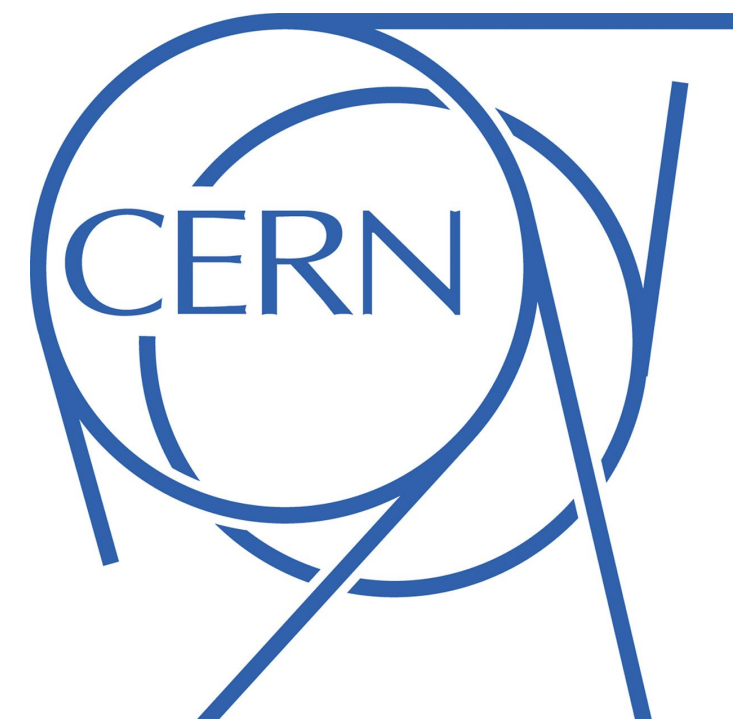


CALICE Collaboration Meeting CERN – September/October 2019
