General News:

Paul and Ron had heard that strategy's national inputs are favoring very strongly an e+e- as the next collider, with a stronger support for a linear. But they are quite neutral between ILC and CLIC. This is also reflected in the summary talks, which have taken place today sofar.

Paul said that the IDR has not changed much lately because of many conferences and workshops, but he will work on them now. The most important thing is to get the dE/dx plot for all three technologies. The IDR drafting meeting will be on 27.-29.5. at DESY.

News from the groups:

Uwe reported that the test beam was successful. He showed several pictures of the setup within PCMAG. It was the first time that both cages were installed with three trackers each. Between them the EUDET telescope was installed to give precise reference tracks. Both telescopes were synchronized and many scans (horizontal, vertical and theta) were done. The signal to noise ratio of LYCORIS is about 10. Uwe has started with implementing a tracking algorithm in MarlinTPC and will show more results once they are available.
