

- This meeting was very much turned towards the future of CALICE
  - Next generation ASIC development appear on the horizon
  - Combined beam tests appear at the Horizon
    - •May have an interest to review and scrutinise our research program for the next years
- CALICE has to make the step into the "sub 100ps" domain
  - Have to make up our minds what we want on which timescale
  - The first step is clearly the deep understanding of existing data
  - Would like to see a dedicated meeting on that between now and the collaboration meeting
- Inspiration for new elements to highly granular calorimeters
  - Dual readout goes granular, 3D SiPMs
  - Must always find ways to integration new efforts
    - MAPS is a nice example how this could work
    - Several MAPS members grew out of CALICE and feed now back into CALICE
- Strategies, HEP Projects and funding
  - Update of European Strategy
  - CALICE has to be well placed in ILC pre<sup>2</sup>patory phase
  - AIDAinnova submission imminent
    - BTW.: My remarks on this are very much biased towards Europe

#### Since January 1<sup>st</sup> 2020
















- IJCLab comprises 800 people from several disciplines
