Diversity Charter for Collaboration

Discussion in the IB



- CALICE has been contacted by Jorgen d'Hondt (ECFA Chair) with the request to consider signing the "Diversity Charter for Collaborations":
 - http://nupecc.org/jenaa/docs/Diversity Charter of APPEC ECFA NuPECC-8.pdf
- By signing the Charter, CALICE would commit to a monitoring of gender, age, career, geographical and citizenship diversity of the collaboration as a whole, and for management positions as well as for assigned conference talks. This information is then regularly transmitted to ECFA.
- The results of this collection of data mentioned in the Charter is the following:

 "The first results of the monitoring will be published in a common document at the latest two years after its entry into force. In the event that the monitoring of these variables will show an inequality of treatment at different levels for the signatory entities, a list of further measures will be proposed to eventually contribute towards the solution of such issues."

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Conclusions from the discussion in the IB:

- Seek clarification on requirements for completeness of statistical information, and on "level" of measures in case of perceived non-compliance
- Set up an ad-hoc discussion in a balanced sub-group of the collaboration to discuss the topic from a wide range of angles and views.

Future Meetings & AOB

In times of COVID
