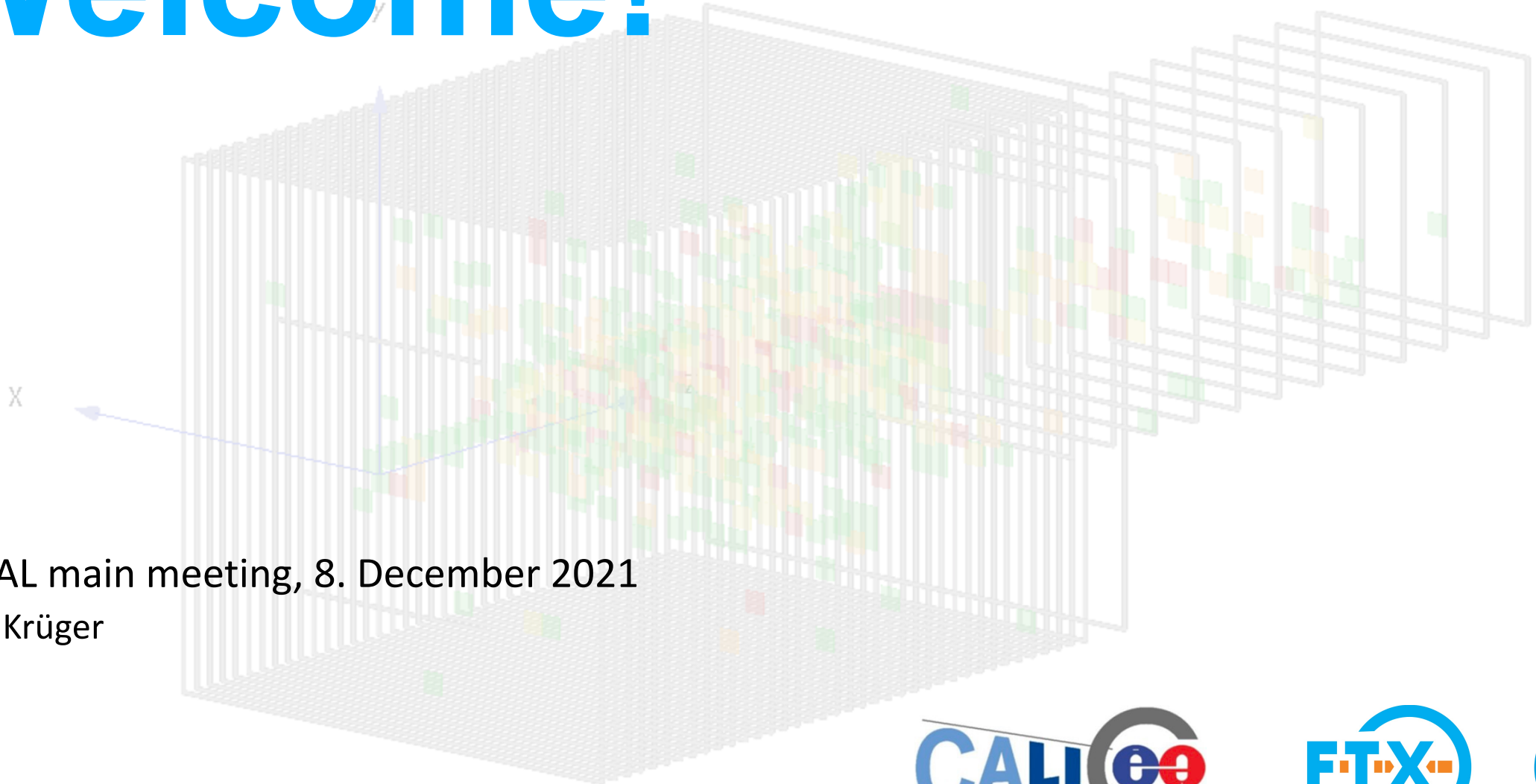

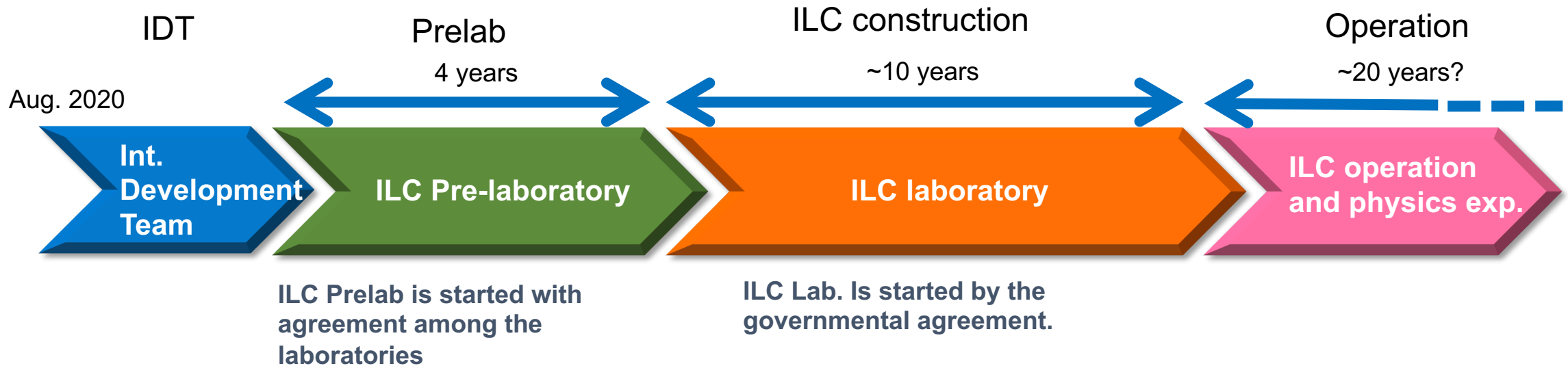

# Situation in Japan

- **Timeline envisioned in 2020**



- **Developments in 2021**

- Pre-lab proposal sent to MEXT, but funding request not submitted (considered pre-mature)
- ILC expert panel re-opened, several meetings (July, October), expect report by March 2022 latest
- In parallel: international discussions between MEXT and US and European governments
- New Organization of ILC Promotion in Japan

# Activities in Europe and the US

- **ECFA Detector R&D Roadmap**

- Started in May 2020
- Based on EPPSU as starting point (priorities and timelines of future projects)
- Final report in print, approved by ECFA in November, presentation to CERN council in December

- **ECFA Studies towards an e<sup>+</sup>e<sup>-</sup> Higgs/EW/Top factory**

- Kickoff meeting in June 2021
- 3 WGs: Physics Potential, Physics Analysis Methods, Detector R&D
- Presentation at the Open Plenary ECFA meeting in November 2021
- Plan series of ECFA workshops in 2022 and 2023
- Final goal: “ECFA report”

- **Snowmass (Particle Physics Community Planning Exercise)**

- Started in 2020
- Collected Letters Of Interest until August 2020
- December 2020: new timeline due to COVID, activities restart in September 2021
- White Paper submission: no later than March 15, 2022
- Preliminary reports by the Frontiers due: no later than June 30, 2022
- Snowmass Community Summer Study (CSS): July, 2022 at UW-Seattle
- Snowmass Book and the on-line archive documents due: October 31, 2022.
