

Membership, Authorship

- The KIT IPE (FS) has applied for CALICE membership: Approved unanimously
- The IB discussed how authors from Russian institutes are represented on the author list of CALICE papers. Reminder: Papers submitted w/o author list for review ("The CALICE Collaboration").
 - Decided to follow the solution adopted by the CERN experiments ("Option C"): Authors from Russian institutes will be included with their names, but their institutes will not be listed. Instead, they will be labelled "Affiliated with an institute that has signed the CALICE MOU". (exact wording still TBD).
- Currently representation of Russian institutions in the IB remains suspended. Spokesperson will collect private views of IB members, issue to be rediscussed.




SpB Chair, Future of CALICE

Correlated topics

- The (extended) term of Francois Corriveau as SpB is coming to an end need a replacement! Search for candidates ongoing.
- In view of the process of the implementation of the ECFA detector R&D roadmap and the formation of new collaborations (DRD collaborations) the future role of CALICE is not fully clear at this point. This topic was discussed with a variety of different perspectives and opinions. General impressions:
 - A forum for global collaboration, as provided by CALICE, is important.
 - Too early to decide if CALICE should fully dissolve into "DRD6" will be revisited once scope and structure of new collaboration better defined
 - Expect the exploitation of CALICE results to continue beyond the start date of "DRD6" (foreseen for 01/2024): Maintaining structures in place to ensure support and reviewing for CALICE publications and conference presentation beyond the beginning of 2024 crucial in all possible scenarios. A new SpB chair is needed!
 - Term of the Spokesperson ending in Fall: Watch "DRD6" developments, start process late spring
